- <u>Transportation</u> Transportation shall be provided by the parent and/or legal guardian.
- <u>District Employees</u> District employees living outside the district shall be allowed to transfer their children. However, they must abide by the same rule as all transfer students or their transfer may be revoked.
- Falsification of Information Any falsification of information shall cause this application for transfer to be denied and/or a transfer to be revoked.
- <u>Attendance/Arrivals/Late pick ups</u> A transfer may be revoked for a documented pattern of late arrivals, late pick ups, and/or poor attendance. Students must attend school 96% or better per six weeks.
- <u>Student Discipline</u> Transfer students must abide by the *Discipline Management Plan and Student Code of Conduct*. A transfer may be revoked for serious or persistent misconduct or for any offense mandating a DAEP or JJAEP placement.
- State Standardized Assessment Transfer students shall be required to meet all state minimum passing standards for their prior and current year grade levels.
- Academic Performance Transfer students are expected to perform to their best abilities in the classroom. Any failure to complete assignments on time, maintain a grade of 70 percent or above in any academic subject may be grounds for immediate revocation of transfer.
- <u>UIL Eligibility</u> Approval of an inter-district transfer does not guarantee UIL varsity athletic eligibility.
- <u>Financial Cost to the District</u> Should any transfer student subject the District to additional financial expenses that exceeds the sum the District receives from state aid sources and in combination with sources from the resident district the transfer resides, the district may revoke or deny the transfer.
- <u>Teacher/Student Ratio</u> If at any time, a transfer student causes our student/teacher ratio to become more than 22:1, the last transfer students taken in that grade level will be returned to their home district to correct our student/teacher ratio.
