The following supplemental programs were provided to students at risk of dropping out of school in New Summerfield ISD during the 2019-2020 school year:

New Summerfield ISD:

- 1) A Prekindergarten Program was provided for qualified students.
- 2) A Reading Intervention Program was provided for students in Kindergarten through fifth grade.
- 3) Instructional Support was provided for students in third through twelfth grade.
- 4) Supplemental Reading Services were provided for students in Prekindergarten through twelfth grade.
- 5) An At-Risk Coordinator was provided for students in Prekindergarten through twelfth grade.
- 6) Counseling Services were provided for students in Prekindergarten through twelfth grade.

The SCE funded programs produced the following results:

- 1) as measured by the number of students who were promoted to the next grade for the Prekindergarten Program.
 - 100% for At-Risk participants in Prekindergarten
- 2) as measured by promotion to the next grade
 - **96%** for first grade At-Risk participants
 - 88% for first grade At-Risk participants
 - 73% for second grade At-Risk participants
- 3) as measured by achieving passing scores on the **Fall Benchmarks**:

- * 56% for third grade At-Risk participants.
- * 46% for fourth grade At-Risk participants.
- * 17% for fifth grade At-Risk participants.
- * 5% for sixth grade At-Risk participants.
- * **16%** for seventh grade At-Risk participants.
- * **54%** for eighth grade At-Risk participants.

Writing

- * 37% for fourth grade At-Risk participants.
- 24% for seventh grade At-Risk participants.

Science

- * **49%** for fifth grade At-Risk participants.
- * **3%** for eighth grade At-Risk participants.

Social Studies

* 40% for eighth grade At-Risk participants.

English I

* 70% for At-Risk participants.

English II

* 77% for At-Risk participants.

Algebra I

70% for At-Risk participants.

Biology

* 93% for At-Risk participants.

U.S. History

* 82% for At-Risk participants.

Evaluation:

These programs are designed to meet the needs of those students in the New Summerfield ISD who are at risk of dropping out of school. Programs that are not successful will be modified in the 2020-2021 school year. If modifications do not improve a program's success rate, the program will be discontinued.
